

SPECIAL EDUCATION

Special Education is designed to assist identified students needing additional social and academic support for successful integration into the mainstream. Class selection is based on Individual Education Plan.

PROGRAM AND SUPPORT SERVICES

CO-TEACHING

General and special education teachers in designated subject area provide direct services to general and special education students in mainstream classes.

CONSULT

Consultation provides contact with teachers and parents with minimum direct educational services to the student. Student progress is monitored and assessed periodically.

RESOURCE CENTER

This program services students who need individualized support as well as instruction in reading, essential skills, and vocational skills.

ALTERNATE SPECIAL EDUCATION PROGRAM (ASEP)

A more restrictive environment is available for students whose performance is enhanced through the use of a highly structured behavior management program.
