



Rockville High School is pleased to introduce the iParent system for parents and guardians for the 2010-2011 school year.

The iParent system is designed to provide an additional option for the sharing of information between parents, teachers, students, and administrators. It is not meant to be a replacement or substitute for telephone conversations, parent/teacher meetings, or any other direct interaction with the school section.

***The iParent system will allow parents to view information for their student(s) only.*

This program requires parents to register for access. Specific information is required before access is granted to ensure security and privacy.

When using the iParent system, parents will be able to view:

- Biographical information (address/phone numbers)
- Assignments (homework and/or classroom)
- Progress Reports (by course)
- Attendance (daily and period)
- Grades (midterm progress and quarter)
- Schedule

In addition, this system provides direct email access to the teachers listed on the schedule screen.

All parents are encouraged to request access to the iParent system.

To request access to the iParent system:

- Visit the Rockville High School website
www.rockvillehighschool.org
- Click on the iPASS link on the left side of the home page
- Click on the application link at the bottom of the iPASS home page and complete the registration form with all required information

You will receive a confirmation email to indicate your application has been received.

Your application will be reviewed by the iParent manager and you will then receive a second email indicating the approval of your access.

Once you receive the approval email, you can log on to the system by clicking on the iPASS link on the RHS website at anytime.

Parents/Guardians will create their own username and password. The school will not maintain this information. If either or both are forgotten, they must reapply for access. Passwords are the sole responsibility of parents/guardians.

Please note:

Completing the iParent application process does not instantly provide parents/guardians with online access.

The school always reserves the right to require additional information and/or that a parent/ guardian visits the school in person prior to final approval.
